Criteria

I. Initial Approval Criteria

A. Hereditary Angioedema (must meet all):

1. Diagnosis of (HAE) confirmed by one of the following (a or b):
 - a. Low C1-INH antigenic or functional level;
 - b. Normal C1-INH levels, and at least one of the following (i or ii):
 - i. Presence of mutations associated with the disease;
 - ii. Recurring angioedema attacks that are refractory to high-dose antihistamine therapy (i.e., cetirizine 40 mg/day or equivalent) for at least 1 month.
2. Prescribed for the prophylaxis of HAE attacks.

Approval duration

All Lines of Business (except Medicare): 12 months

II. Continued Therapy Approval

A. Hereditary Angioedema (must meet all):

1. Auto-approval based on lookback functionality within the past 120 days as a proxy for member responding positively to therapy.
